COVID-19 Drive-Thru Testing November 1, 2020

Madison County Public Health (MCPH) and Rocking Horse Community Health Center (RHCHC) will be offering drive-thru COVID-19 testing on the first three Fridays in November in partnership with the Ohio National Guard and Mako Medical. The drive-thru testing will be located at the Molly Caren Agricultural Center, which is home of Farm Science Review.

Anyone can get a free test at this location. No doctor's order or appointment is needed but pre-registration is encouraged. You can pre-register in under five minutes by calling 740-845-1756. There is no cost for a test and no insurance information is collected.

"We want to ensure that any Madison County resident can get tested when needed," said Health Commissioner Chris Cook. "Our goal is that anyone with symptoms of COVID-19 or those who think they may have been exposed to a case or someone with symptoms will get tested. There is not a more convenient option than from your own vehicle, especially for those who are elderly or parents of children." Symptoms of COVID-19 include fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea.

Test results are expected to be received within two to three days. After being tested, you can view your results online using the information provided at the testing clinic.

Enter the testing clinic from Route 40 and be sure to drive slowly, use caution, remain in your car, and stay in your lane. Everyone in the car is required to wear a mask until a healthcare professional asks you to lower it for testing.

1. **Call 740-845-1756** and select **option 5** to pre-register for a test (it only takes about 5 minutes).
2. **Arrive** at the **Molly Caren Agricultural Center** testing clinic using the entrance on Route 40. Look for the PUBLIC HEALTH flags. →
3. **Drive slowly**, use caution, remain in your car, and stay in your lane.
4. **Wear a mask** until a healthcare professional asks you to lower it for testing.
5. **Access** your results online using the information provided at the testing clinic.

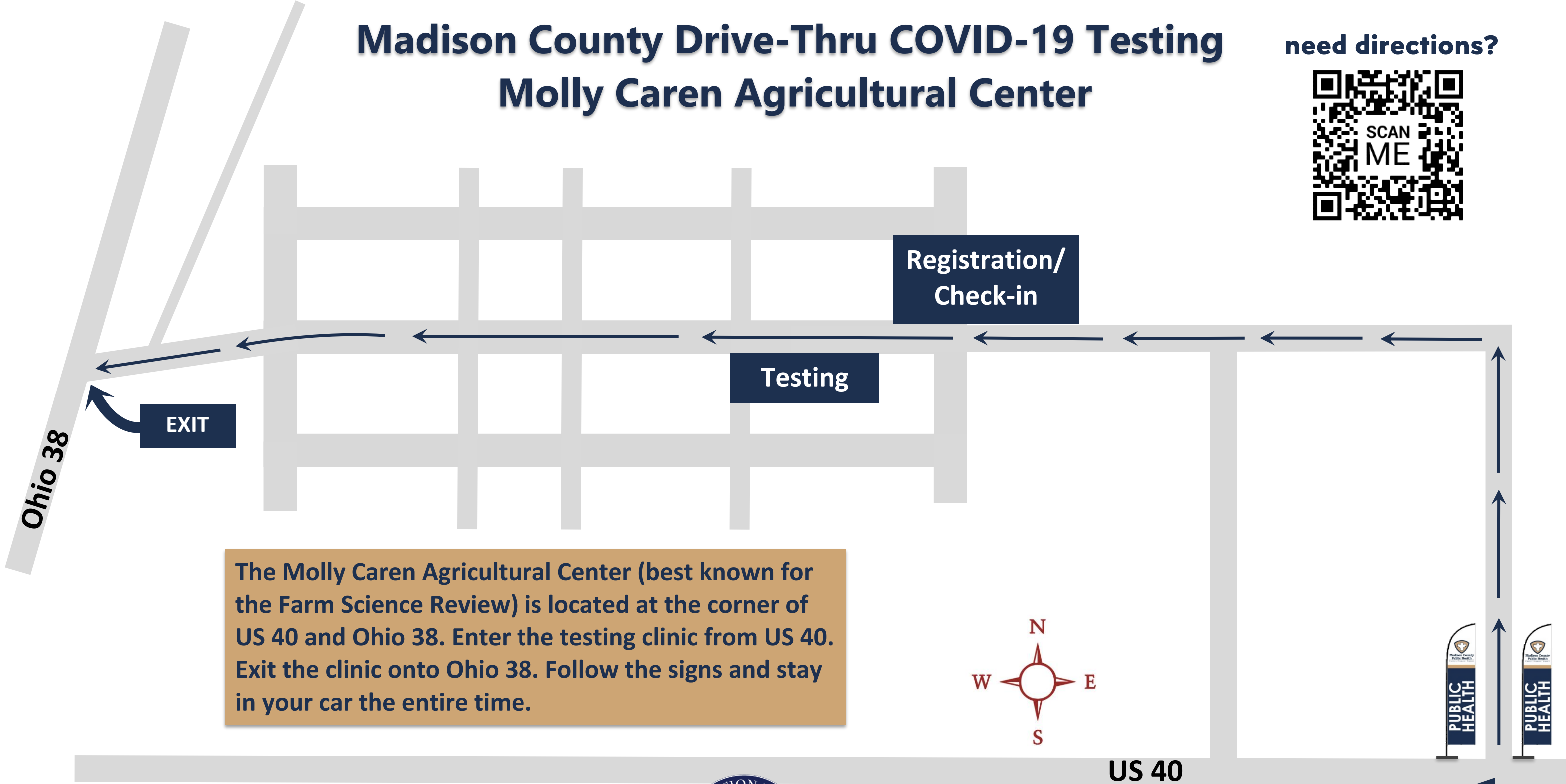
