Not sick



No testing

Mild illness



No testing

Fever and cough like a cold that isn't too bad and you can manage it at home ok.

Severe illness



Seek testing

Shortness of breath, chest pain, coughing up stuff for more than a week & still have a fever, hospitalization.

Only a doctor can order testing. Call your doctor & tell them your symptoms. Emergencies call 911.

Most doctor's offices do not offer testing right now.

If you have a mild fever and cough you should stay at home (isolate yourself) for at least 14 days OR for at least one week after your fever and cough go away.
