

Job Posting – Trail Maintenance Worker

The Madison County Engineer has a job opening for the position of Trail Maintenance Worker. This position is a temporary, seasonal highway maintenance position with responsibility to perform a variety of manual labor tasks to assist in the maintenance of bike trails and other common areas associated with the Park District and other county owned facilities, mow grass and remove unwanted vegetation, trim trees and remove brush, repair fence and any structures along the trail, debris removal, and other maintenance responsibilities. Applicants will be considered if they can work with a sense of urgency and a desire to serve the public on our dynamic, driven team. They must also possess a valid Ohio Driver's License and a good work record. The selected applicant must submit to and pass a post-offer drug test, criminal background check, and driving check that demonstrates insurability under the County's insurance plan.
