Effective January 1, 2022, due to Covid-19, the National Emergency, and the safety of everyone, until further notice **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that anyone entering the courtroom **MUST** wear a mask. This mask must be worn at all times with the following exception:

If you are in the courtroom for a court proceeding and will be speaking, while you are speaking you may remove the mask.

If you are in the courtroom attending a proceeding but not speaking, you are to wear your mask for the duration of your time at the courtroom.


If you appear for a hearing and do not have a mask, one will be provided to you.

You shall adhere to the rule of six (6) feet of distance between you and anyone else.
