



Permit Process

- Permits for all plumbing work (both commercial and residential) are issued by Madison County Public Health at our office located at: 306 Lafayette Street, London 43140. Phone 740-852-3065.
- Permit fees are paid directly to Madison County Public Health.
- Madison County Public Health office hours are Monday through Friday 8:30am to 4:30pm.
- The permit application form has been significantly revised – please begin using the new permit application form immediately.
- The permit application form is the same for both commercial and residential work.
- A permit application form has been included with this letter.
- The permit application form is available on our website at madisonpublichealth.org.

Inspection Request Process

- Plumbing inspections are performed by Franklin County Public Health.
- To schedule an inspection, call 614-525-3160 or visit madisonpublichealth.org to complete an online inspection request.
- Online inspection requests are accepted until 7:00am for same-day inspections.
- Franklin County Public Health office hours are Monday through Friday 8:00am to 5:00pm.

Registration Process

- Plumbers performing work in Madison County will register with Madison County Public Health.
- Registration fees are paid to Madison County Public Health.
- Registration is required before applying for a plumbing permit and before performing any work.
- Required documentation for registration includes: registration form, current surety bond of \$5,000 naming Madison County Public Health, current proof of liability insurance of at least \$250,000, and a copy of your state plumbing/contractor license if you will be performing commercial work.
- If you registered in Madison County in 2017 you will receive a registration renewal packet for 2018 in the mail at the end of November.

Plan Review Process

- Plan reviews are required for all commercial work in Madison County.
- Plan reviews are performed by Franklin County Public Health. Reviews take 1-2 weeks to complete.
- Plans should be submitted directly to Franklin County Public Health. Their offices are located at 280 East Broad Street, Columbus 43215. Phone: 614-525-3160.
- Plan review fees are paid directly to Franklin County Public Health.
- Plans must be approved before applying for a permit and before beginning work.
- The plan review application form has been significantly revised – please begin using the new plan review application form immediately.
