#### **GUY CEMETERY**

The Guy Cemetery is located on Guy Cemetery Road in Pike Township, Madison County, Ohio. It was originally used as a family ground by the Guy Family and later deeded by the Guy family to the Pike Township Trustees as a permanent cemetery for the general internment of the dead (Beers, 1883). The cemetery serves today as the Pike Twp. cemetery. It has been fenced and expanded since it was first dedicated as a cemetery and is currently cared for and maintained by the Pike Township Trustees. It was inventoried by Michael Jones on June 20 & Aug 9, 1987. The symbol † indicates that the individual is listed on the same marker as the previous individual. For example Emma Lee McCarty and Ross McCarty Jr. are listed on the same marker.
